2. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED OF APPLICANT

Applicants must meet the following initial qualifications as shown below:

- a. Be not less than 18 years of age at time of their acceptance into the Apprenticeship program.
- b. Must submit proof of age at time of application.
- c. Must be a high school graduate or possess a GED Certificate prior to placement into the Apprenticeship program.
- d. A transcript of the applicants high school record or G.E.D. scores must be submitted prior to placement into the Apprenticeship program.
- e. Applicants must present a valid Government issued photo I.D. along with their social security card at the time of application.
- f. If selected, each Apprentice candidate will be required, prior to job placement, to pass a physical examination indicating that they can perform the work of the trade.
- g. Must be able to pass a drug screen prior to acceptance into the apprenticeship program.
- h. Must submit to a criminal background check.
- i. Veteran applicants must submit a form, DD214 indicating that they have received an Honorable Discharge from the military.
- j. Veterans not possessing an Honorable Discharge will be ruled in-eligible, and receive no further consideration.
- k. Applicants will sign up for the oral interview and rating session before the committee on the day of application.
- 1. Applicants failing to appear for their scheduled interview will be disqualified, and receive no further consideration.
- m. It is strongly recommended that each applicant read these standards, when the application is made.
- n. Applicants must make application in person, at the designated location shown on the "Notice of Openings" letter, sent out by the Committee.
